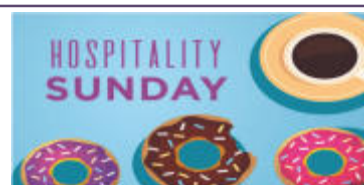

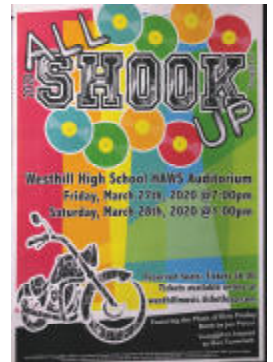

Respect Life

New York Law Bans Pro-Life Principles in Catholic Schools, Colleges

Gov. Andrew Cuomo has signed New York's "Boss Bill" into law, telling employers including Catholic schools and colleges that "they have to be willing to employ people whose beliefs and behavior as to 'reproductive-health decisions' run counter to their own, according to attorney Denise Harle of Alliance Defending Freedom. ADF has filed a lawsuit against the state to try to halt the law, which is clearly unconstitutional.
