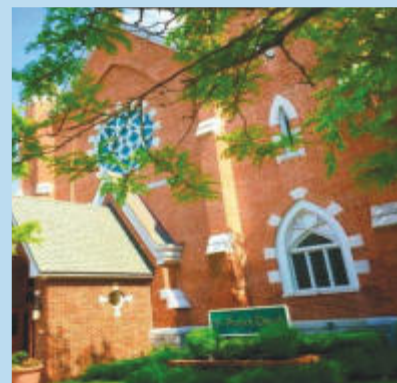

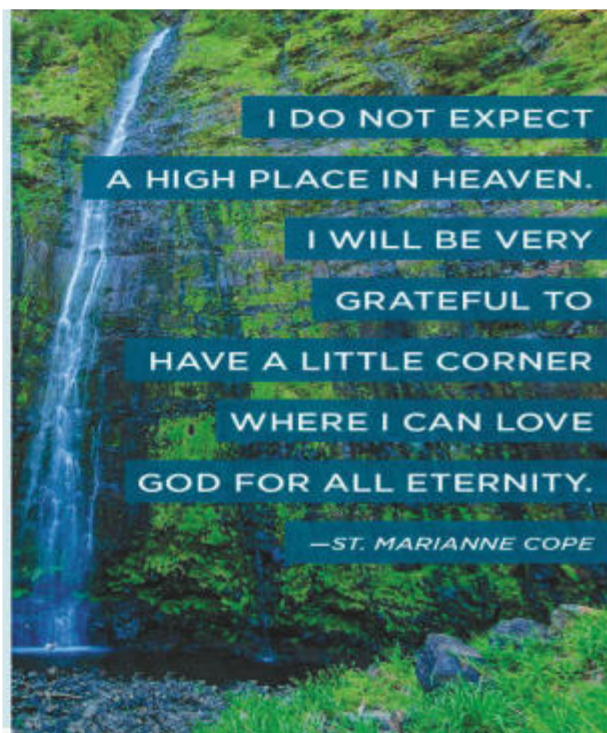

### Respect Life

In January, 2019, New York's legislature enacted the RHA, which permits the killing of viable or pre-viable unborn children for *any reason* up to 24 weeks of pregnancy, or where there is an absence of fetal viability, or at any time *through birth* where the abortion is necessary to protect the patient's life or health. Health is not defined, but all indicators point towards the broadest possible interpretation in New York. The RHA also redefines "person" in the criminal law so that the taking of any life, whether wanted or not, before live birth is *not a homicide*. That change alone enhances the risk of violence against pregnant women seeking to carry their pregnancy to term, their viable unborn children and children surviving abortions attempted after the 20th week of pregnancy.

## Guidelines for Mass at St. Patrick's & St. Brigid's Church

St. Patrick's & St. Brigid's Church will be opening weekend 8/8-9, 2020.

The Mass schedule will be Saturday at 4:00pm and Sunday at 8:00am.

Everyone **MUST** wear a mask at all times. Please bring a pocket- size sanitizer for your personal use.

Since the crowd size is limited to 125 people, it is necessary to make a **"RESERVATION"** every week to attend a particular Mass. Please call the Parish Office at St. Patrick's (315) 475-2185 Tuesday-Thursday from 9:00am -2:00pm to make a reservation.

**Entrance to the Church is at the Lowell Ave Handicap Entrance Only.** All doors will be available after Mass to exit.

When entering the church please keep the **Social Distance** of six feet. Families who reside in the same residence and married couples may sit together, but must maintain six feet from other families and individuals. People will be directed to sit by the ushers. As you enter, please **sanitize your hands** and the ushers will direct you to your seat.

Missalettes are not allowed. Singing for the congregation is also strongly discouraged.

The passing of the basket for offertory is not allowed. Envelopes should be placed in the boxes at entrance to the church. (*A great reason to move to electronic giving! Instruction available at [www.stpatricksandstbrigids.org](http://www.stpatricksandstbrigids.org)*)

**Holy Communion:** Social distance must be kept when approaching the Priest or Eucharistic Minister. We'll distribute communion first on the Lowell Ave. side then the Parking lot side. Everyone must keep the mask on when approaching. Again we ask everyone to receive the Eucharist respectfully in your hand in order to minimize any risk for the Priest or Eucharist Minister. **Keep the mask on as you receive communion.** After receiving, step to the side, lower your mask and then consume the host. After Mass is finished, proceed immediately to the near exit. Please do not socialize in a group after Mass or in the parking lot. The Church must be cleared immediately so that it can be disinfected for the next Mass.

## THE POWER OF A SIMPLE ACTION

I remember seeing a story on a morning news program about a little girl who wanted to give an elderly man in a grocery store a hug. She had no way of knowing that this man had just lost his wife of many years and now felt so very alone and depressed. Her reaching out to the man seemed odd to her mom at first, but the girl was so insistent about giving a hug she moved the shopping carts close together so the exchange could take place. No one knew that from that moment on the little girl would ask to visit her new friend at least once a week for the next four years until he passed away. In an interview soon after the initial encounter, the man said, "I haven't been this happy in some time." Imagine the joy that

relationship brought to them both over the years!

It was just a moment. It was a simple gesture. Yet, it had a large impact that no one could have predicted. You never know what will result when we give just a little of ourselves.
