#### Respect Life

When the Human Fetal Tissue Research Ethics Advisory Board of the National Institute of Health (NIH) met on July 31, they were tasked to advise the Health Secretary on the ethics of using fetal tissue from aborted babies on federally funded research proposals. Research using aborted fetal tissue at NIH facilities was halted by the Trump administration in 2019. The Ethics Advisory Board was appointed to consider government funding for research outside of the NIH. Calling for an end to the moratorium, some researchers claim that using fetal tissue could be vital in finding a cure for COVID-19. Research companies are working on vaccines using aborted fetal cells. We pray for a strong defense of life from this board, which includes Father Tadeusz Pacholczyk and other distinguished leaders in bioethics.

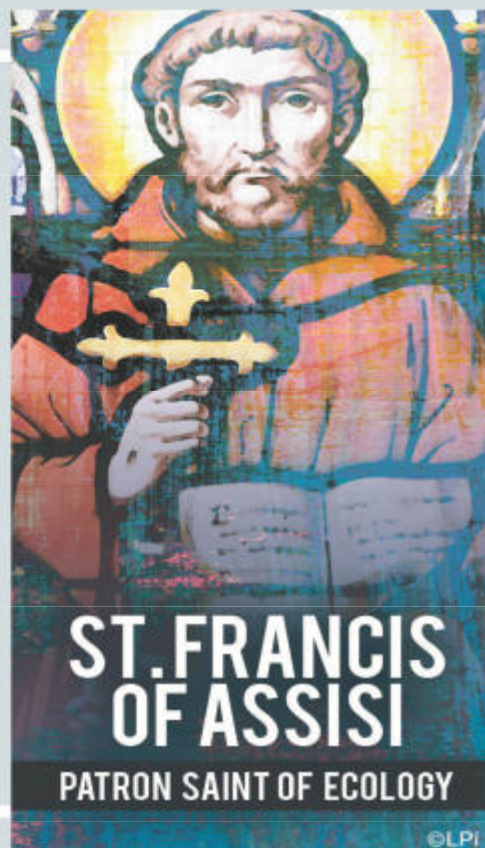
