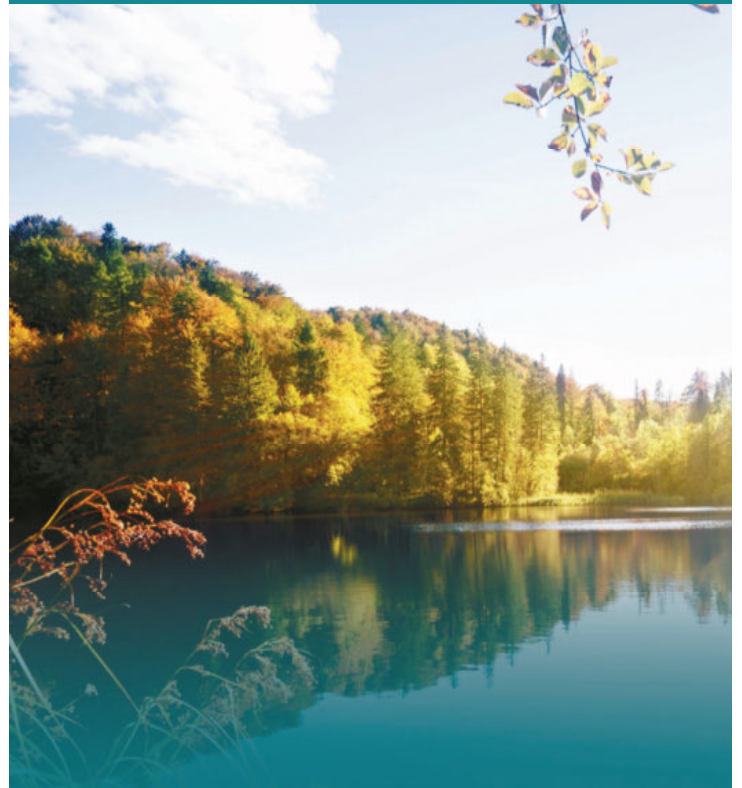

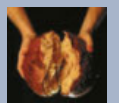

The annual Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Syracuse will take place in our parishes at Mass on Saturday, August 6th and Sunday, August 7th .

The congregation making the appeal will be the Brothers of the Christian Schools, who are also known as the Christian Brothers and as the De La Salle Brothers. Founded by St. John Baptist de La Salle (Patron Saint of Teachers) in 1680, the Brothers currently number 2,500 in the world, working in 80 countries, where their ministries teach over one million students. In the District of Eastern North America (DENA), the ministries of the Brothers cover the geographical areas from Washington, DC and Pennsylvania to Detroit, MI, Toronto and the New England states, and locally here at Christian Brothers Academy (CBA).

Eight Brothers from the District of Eastern North America are currently engaged in missionary work in Bethlehem, Nigeria, Kenya, Ethiopia and Viet Nam. The generosity of our parishioners will directly help poor students receive an education (and thus, hope for their future) that they would otherwise not be able to attain. In advance, thank you for your generosity! Representing the Brothers of the Christian Schools will be Brother Joseph Jozwiak, FSC who is the former President at Christian Brothers Academy in Syracuse and is now Special Advisor to the President at CBA
