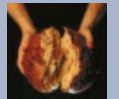

"Catch'em Being Good" contest for altar servers

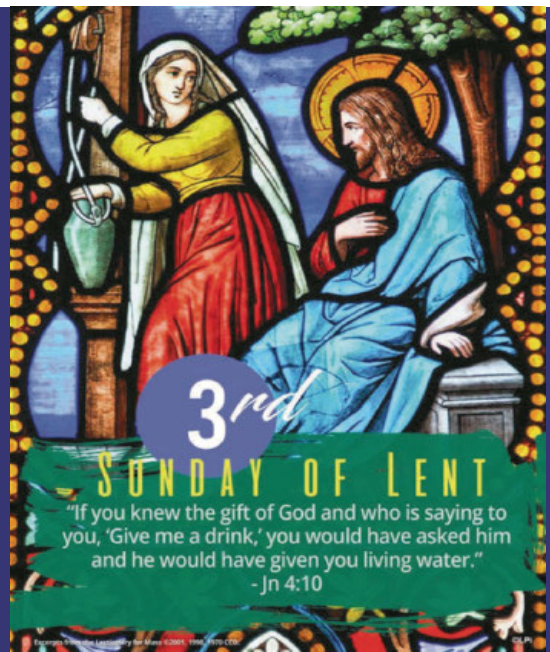

- June 3rd singing at 4pm Saturday Mass



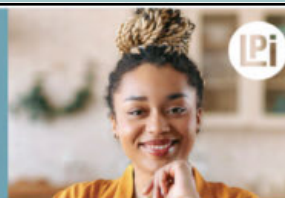
