

Dear Members of our parish community,





The Our God Reigns Prayer Group meets Tuesdays at St. Charles in the sacristy. 3pm. Please join us!


The Blessed and Broken prayer group will not meet in person for prayer on Thursday December 26th and Thursday January 2nd. As always, the prayers will continue.
