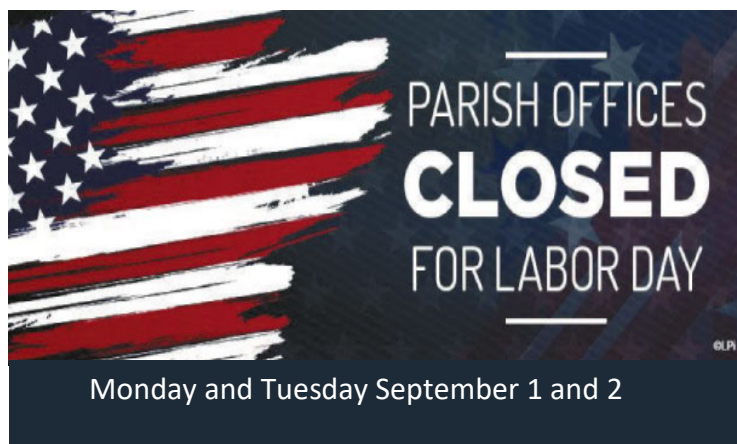
We are still in need of school supplies. Our most needed food items are Peanut butter and jelly, crackers and soups of all kinds. Thank you!

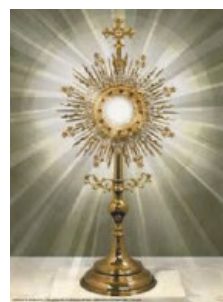

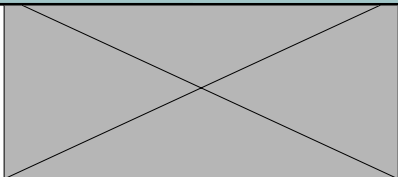
