Liturgical Minister Training: Commentators, Greeters, Ushers, Homebound Ministry

All liturgical ministers must complete Safe Environment training and a criminal background check, reflecting the Diocese's commitment to protecting the vulnerable. Though they may not regularly interact with children, youth, or vulnerable adults, liturgical ministers serve as safe adults within our parish community.

Beginning January 1, 2026, **Commentators, Greeters, Ushers**, and those involved in **Homebound Ministry** must complete Safe Environment training by **September 30, 2026**.

Please also continue to remind **Music Ministry** to meet this requirement by **March 31, 2026** and **Sacristans, Adult Altar Servers, Liturgical Ministry Leaders, and Lectors**, by **June 30, 2026**.

If you would like companionship as you walk your spiritual journey, come and join us. Come as you please—every month, once in a while or once just to see what it is like.

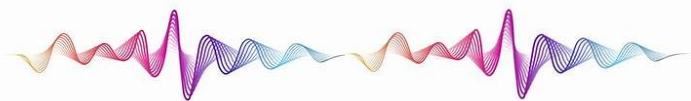

RESPECT LIFE

St. Gianna Molla was a wife, mother and pediatrician. When she was pregnant with her fourth child, she discovered that she had a fibroma on her uterus. While an abortion could have saved the young mother's life, she refused the procedure. She once said, "Love and sacrifice are closely linked, like the sun and the light. We cannot love without suffering, and we cannot suffer without love." She died at age 39, a few days after the baby, Gianna Emanuela, was born. This child later became a geriatric doctor and now tours the world, speaking about her mother's legacy. St. Gianna is also a patron saint of the unborn.
