Planned Parenthood's annual report: More abortions, funding

While there were a number of pro-life victories in 2019, Planned Parenthood's latest annual report shows a continued increase in the number of abortions performed for the 2018-2019 fiscal year. According to the report released January 6, the number of abortions performed nationwide increased by 3%, and government funding increased by more than 8%. And while Planned Parenthood withdrew from the Title X program in August, after the Trump administration finalized the "Protect Life Rule," attempts to defund the organization last year were stopped in the Senate. Many have noted the important pro-life cases the Supreme Court will hear in 2020, but we must remember that every effort- both in private prayer and the public sphere- can make a difference to end abortion in our country.

Blessings in a backpack is a program where food is sent home on Fridays with children who would otherwise be hungry. The food needs to be in small quantity form. Examples of what we are looking for is fruit cups, mac and cheese, small bowls or boxes of cereal, shelf stable milk, pasta bowls, vegetable and chicken soups, nutrigrain snacks, granola bars, dried fruits,
